How many?	87,683	51,090	20,432	4,084	474	163,763



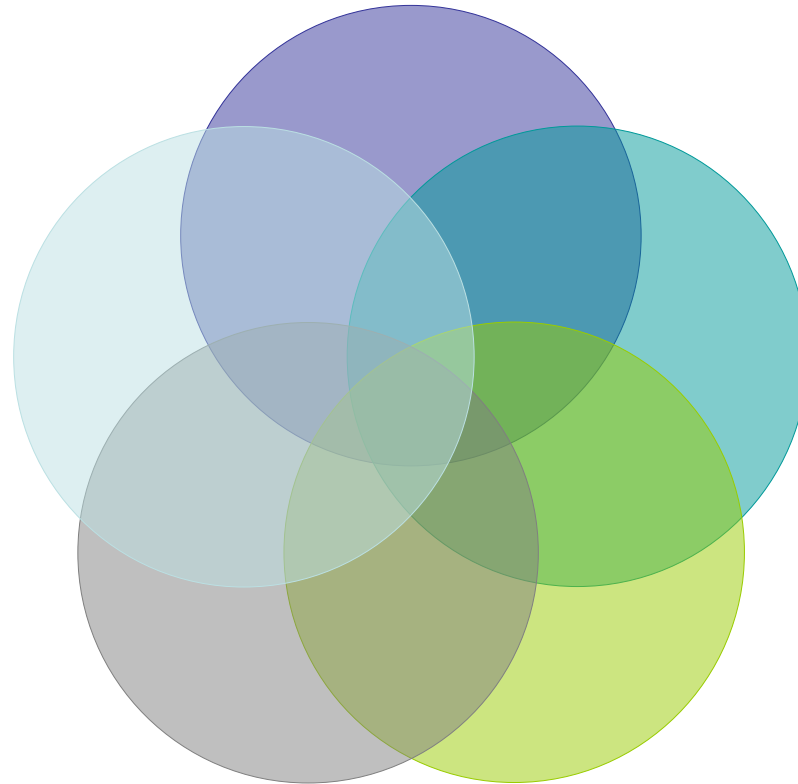
58.2% work with children and young people

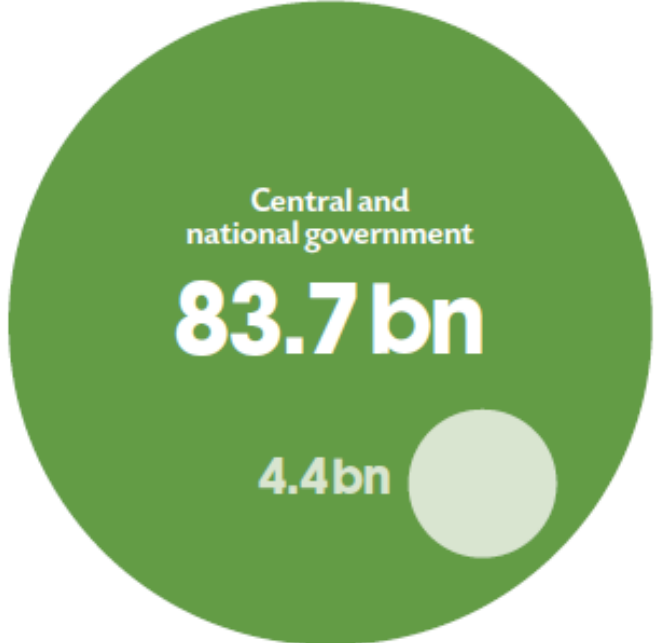

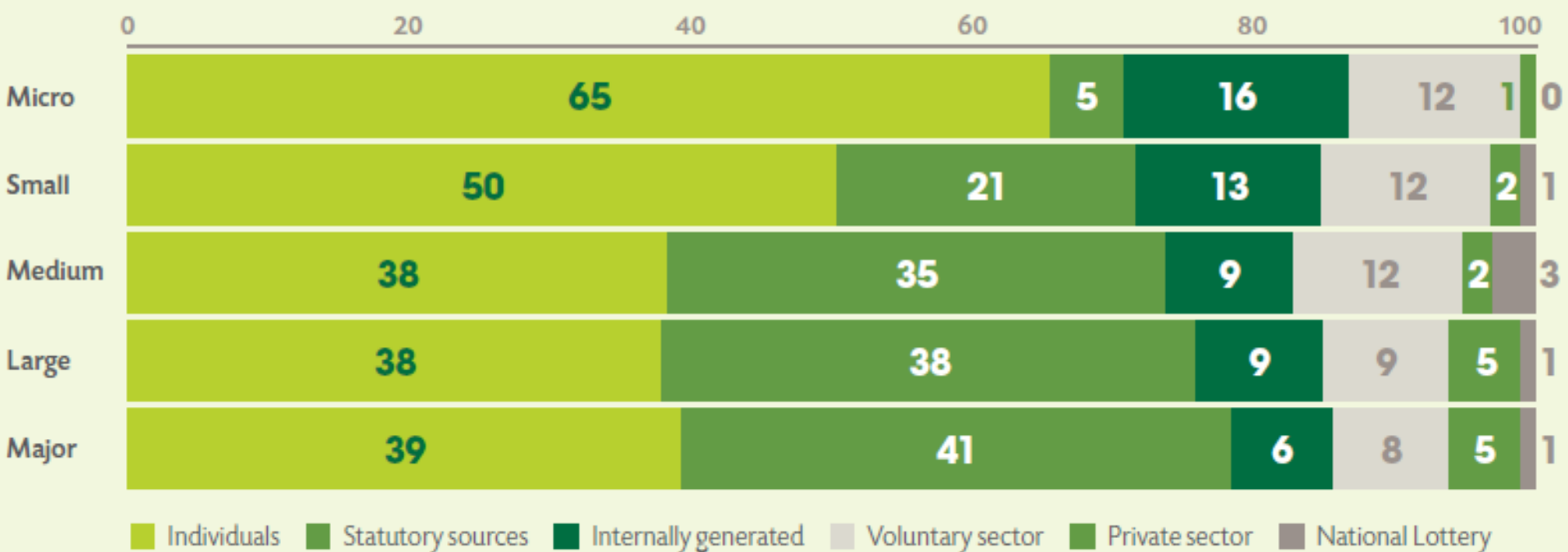

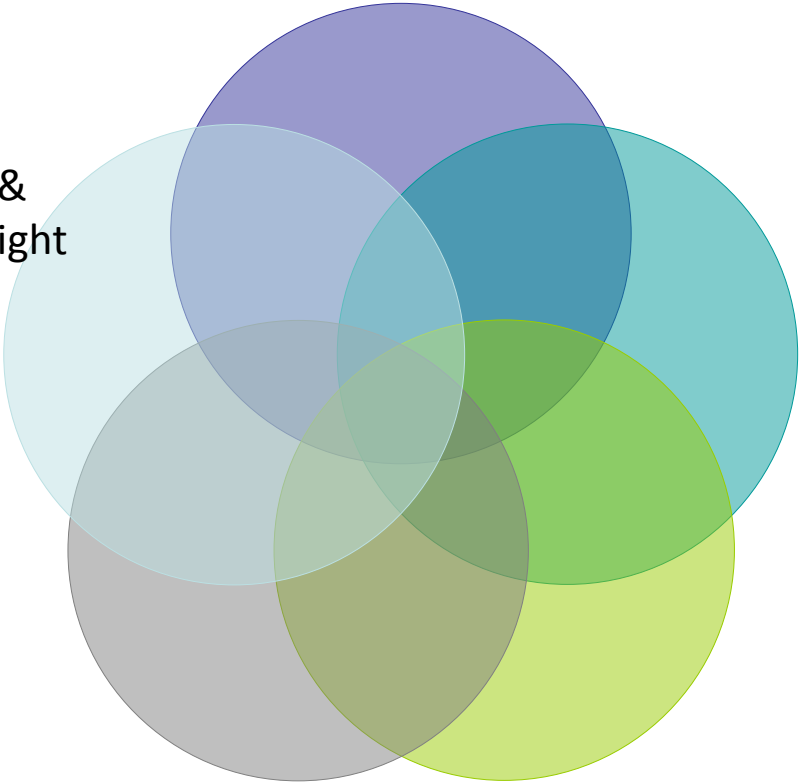

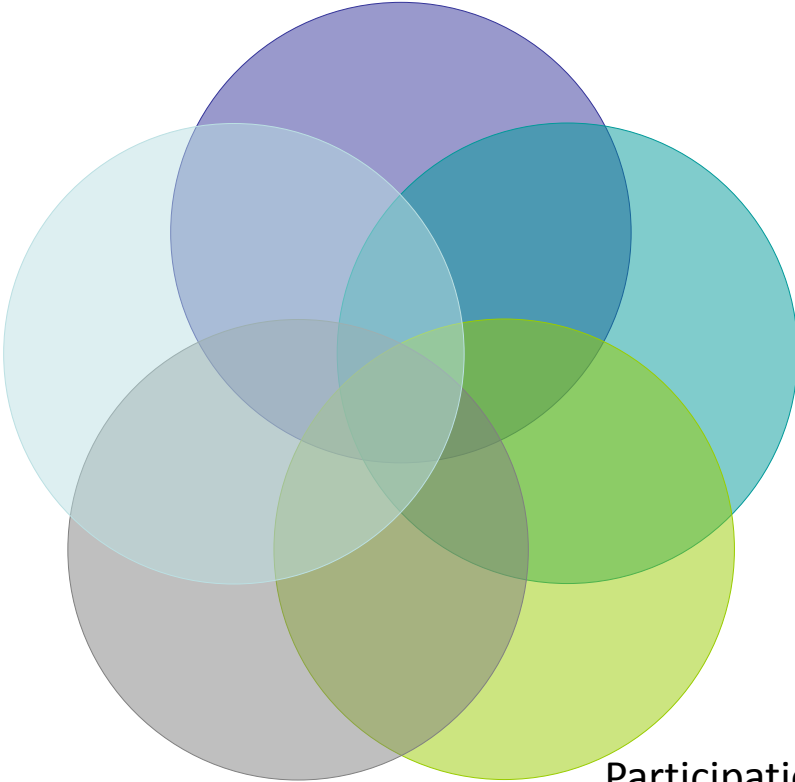
Source of income to voluntary organisations by size of organisation, 2009/10 (%)



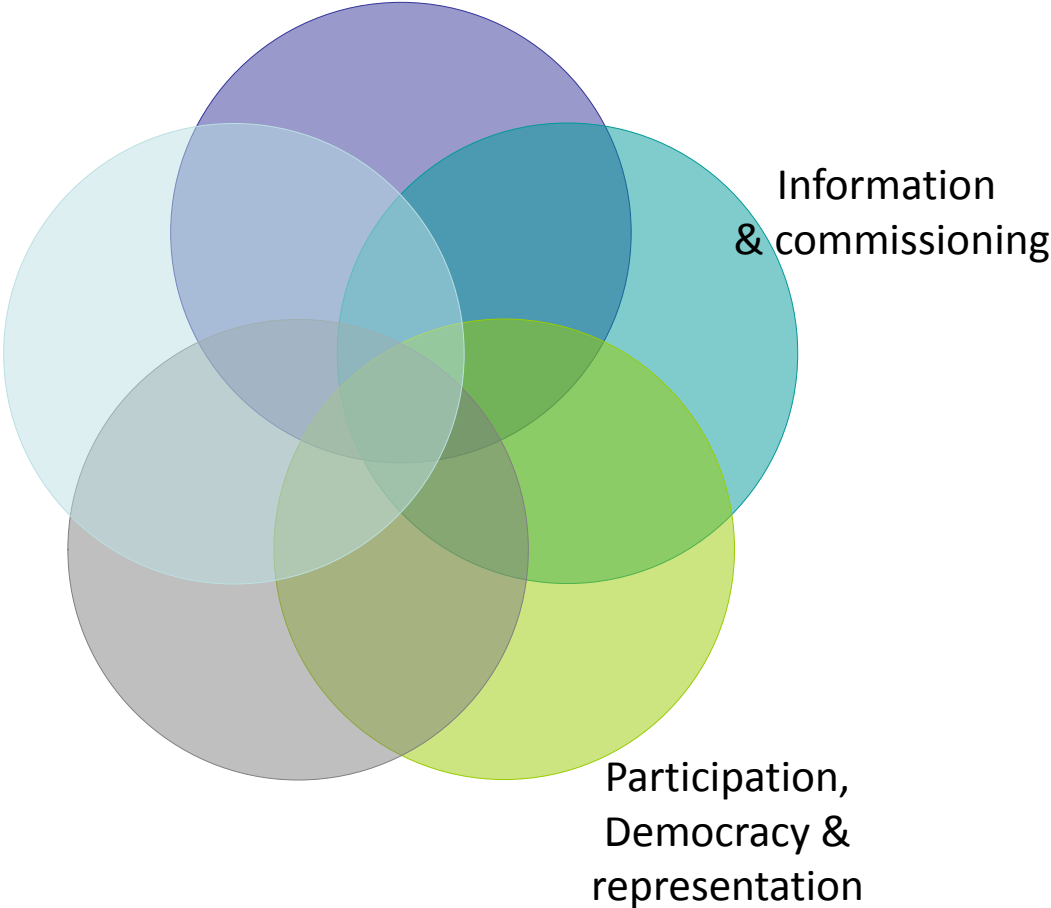

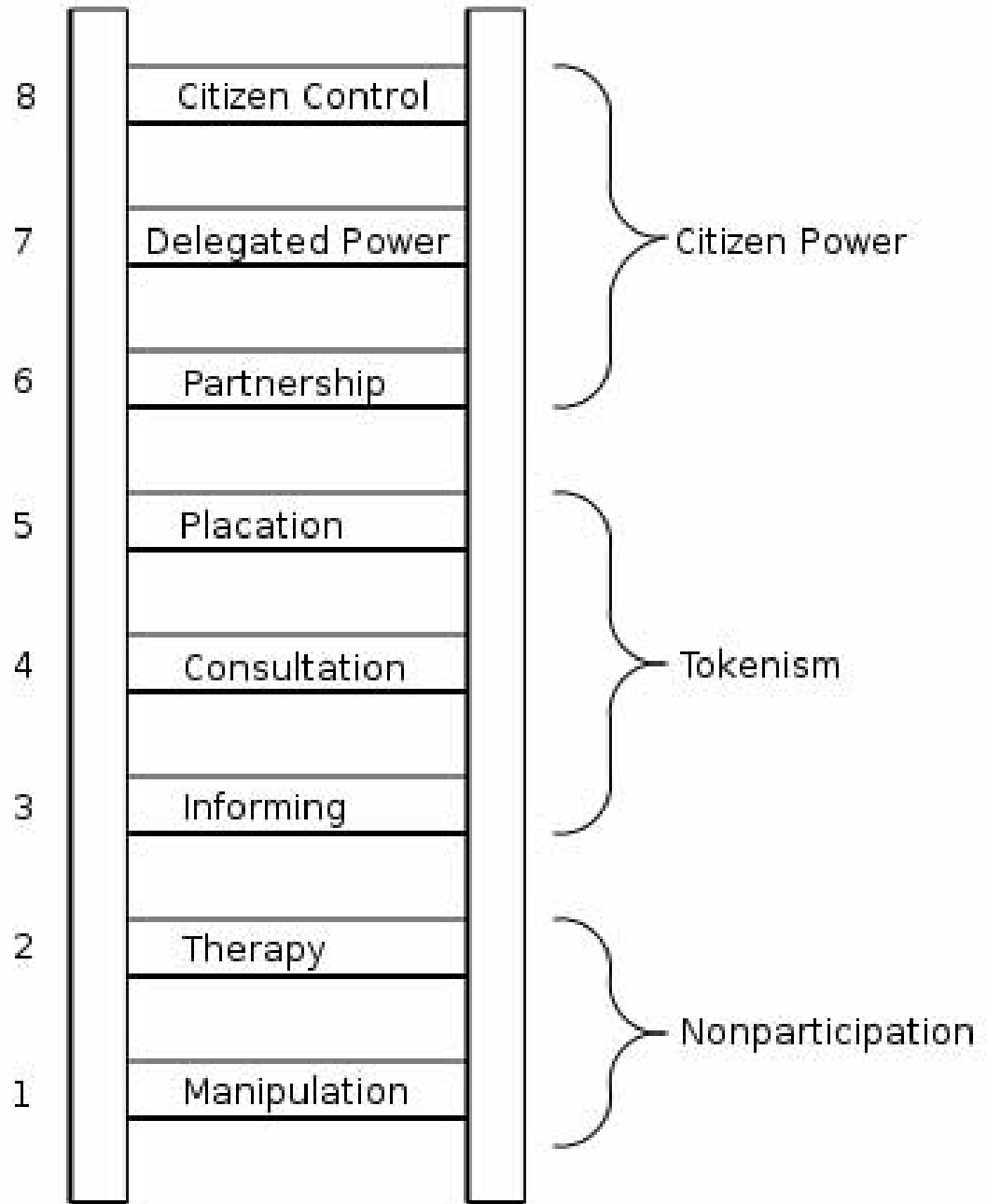

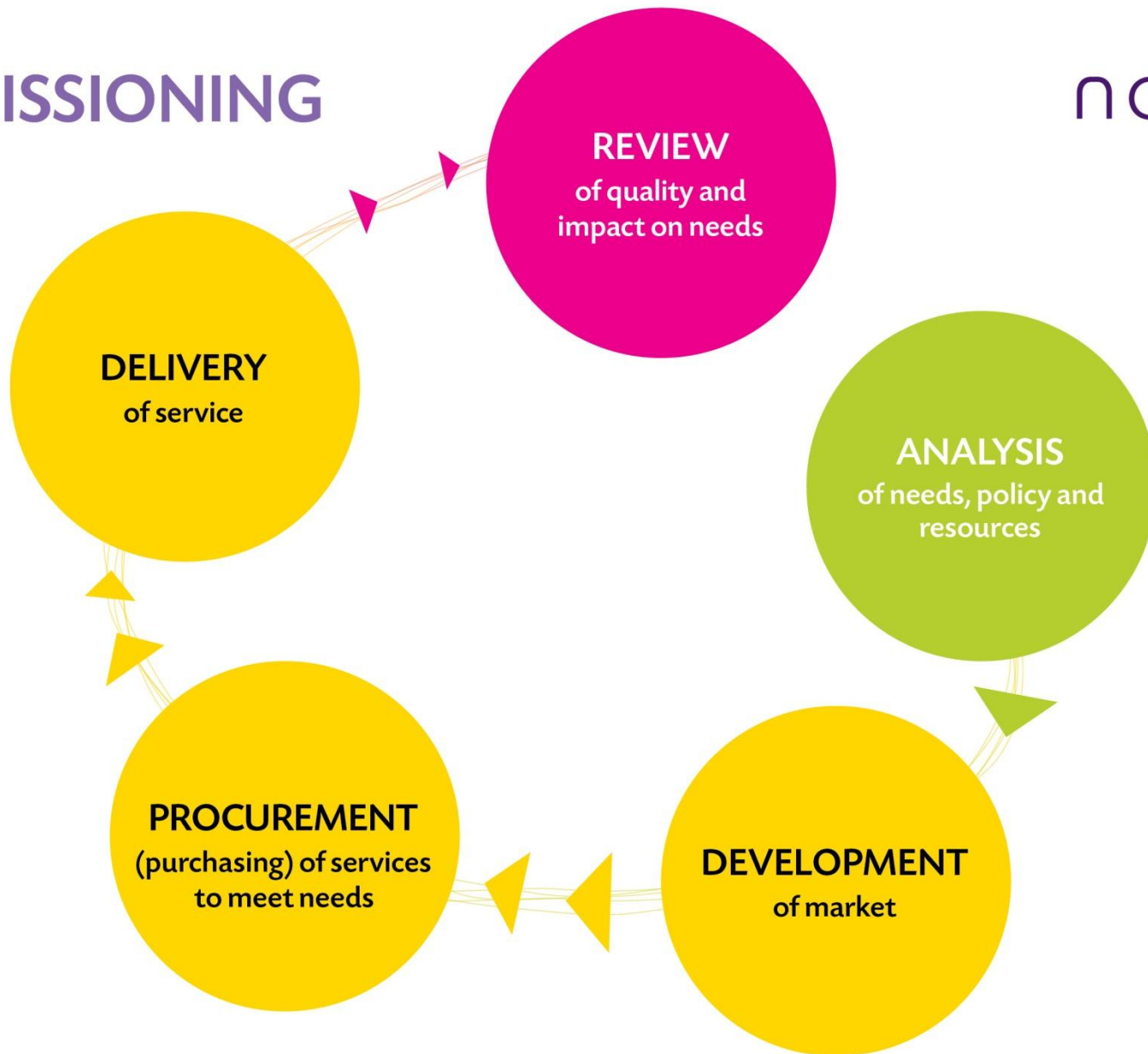
